



How to call CCMM

The CCMM (French TMAS) assures 24/24H the answer for the emergency medical problem at sea and proposes a telemedical service for advice concerning not urgent medical problem during the week from 08 AM to 18 PM. The connection can be established with the doctor of the CCMM via a coastal station (MRCC, CROSS in France) by the marine VHF, by the "BLU marine" or by the Inmarsat C station or FleetBroadband.

RADIO VHF et BLU : CROSS-MRCC

- **VHF** : near the coast (*maritime area A1*)
 - Digital selective calling : *ALL SHIP URGENCY* **Canal 70**
 - Radiotelephony : *PAN PAN – Médical* **Canal 16**
- **BLU en MF ou HF** : far from the coast (*maritime area A2, A3, A4*)
 - Digital selective calling : *ALL SHIPS URGENCY* **2187.5 ou 8414,5 kHz**
 - Radio telephony : *PAN PAN - Médical* **2182 ou 8291 kHz**

- **CCMM** **+33 5 34 39 33 33**
- Numbers 32 and 38 are routed according to the ocean area where the vessel is located to JRCC Norfolk, Den Helder or JRCC Australia.

- **Select the station (LES) : France telecom « Aussaguel » -free-**
 - SATELLITE AOR W **021**
 - SATELLITE POR **221**
 - SATELLITE AOR E **121**
 - SATELLITE IOR **321**
- **Then :** **32 (telemedical advise) or 38 (emergency)**
